This position will work with Curl Regina, the Highland Curling Club, and the Caledonian Curling Club to develop, organize and execute strategies to grow our curling leagues and help enhance programs for youth and adult curlers. It will report to a Curl Regina Board committee while working closely with the two Club Managers.

Who we are:

Curl Regina is a member-driven organization committed to the development of curling at all levels within Regina and area through programs and facilities dedicated to sport and recreation. The two member clubs of Curl Regina are the Highland Curling Club (a six-sheet facility on north Broad Street) and the Caledonian Curling Club (a twelve-sheet facility on Sandra Schmirler Way near the airport).

What you will do:

- Develop strategies to increase number and enhance the qualifications of curling instructors in the Regina area.
- Further develop, promote, and help execute junior curling programs such as Curl for Kids, Learn to Curl for Youth, Learn to Curl for Adults and other such programs, including possible integration with Curl Canada programs such as Rocks and Rings.
- Coordinate with curling clubs to ensure programs are delivered within available ice times.
- Provide leadership to the marketing, communications, and promotional activities to grow the sport of curling in Regina area.
